Ashira Lashem B'Chayyai - I Will Sing to God with my Whole Being

Prayer is an ancient art that requires preparation, musicality, and discernment. To take the congregation on a prayer journey, we must be able to understand the map and be ready to be on that journey ourselves. Over the course of these three zoom sessions, we will explore different modalities of prayer including: the literal meaning of the liturgy, prayers in and out of context, traditional nusach, melody choices, and different ways to engage the community, with the goal of creating a competent and engaged core of daveners and shlichei tzibbur (pray-ers and prayer leaders).
